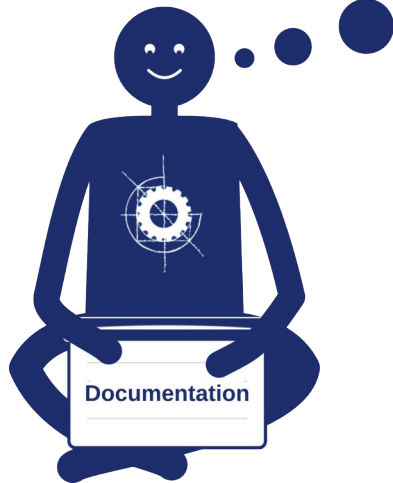

Why is documentation important



This is my documentation.
There are many like it,
but this one is mine.
Without me,
my documentation is useless.
Without my documentation,
I am useless.

**Even the greatest product is useless
if people cannot learn how to use it.**

The current state of midPoint documentation

- Our documentation is rich in content
 - Extensive feature reference
 - Wide range of how-to and tutorial materials
 - Product-agnostic IGA knowledge
- Our documentation lacks
 - Coverage of real-life scenario solutions
 - GUI-centered configuration reference

How we improve the documentation

- New content to fill in coverage gaps
- Improve the search
- Contribute to midPoint UI copy

Content improvements

- Cover real-life scenario solutions
 - We digest the mailing list to map problems you face and cover them with how-to guides
- Cover missing midPoint concept explanations
- Cover midPoint GUI to complement XML configuration reference
 - GUI accelerates onboarding new engineers to midPoint
- Restructure existing materials based on their purpose
 - Our aim is clearer structure following the industry best practices

New content in numbers

Since February 2025:

- 129 new articles written
- 125 articles significantly updated
- 4 out of 9 identified mailing list scenarios covered
 - Processed period: 6 months (Sept 2025–Mar 2026)
 - We continue to watch the mailing list

Search improvements

- We analyzed the search engine performance based on popularity and usefulness of results
- Based on the analysis:
 - We add and optimize the content
 - We tune the search engine and optimize query evaluation
- Tuning increased result quality by ~30 %, query evaluation optimization by ~15 %

New expert search

- Enable searching for exact phrases, use regexes, limit search to certain fields, limit searched versions range, define max. distance between words ...
- Examples:
 - `qs:text:(authentication OR authorization) AND NOT deprecated:true AND since:4.9`
 - `qs:text:"midPoint is awesome"~5`
 - `qs:title:/au[a-z]h/`
 - `qs:/behaviour?r/`

Improve midPoint UI copy

- With midPilot, a lot of new screens are added to midPoint
- We focus on making the UI copy polished and easy to understand
- Relevant documentation excerpts will be accessible directly in midPoint

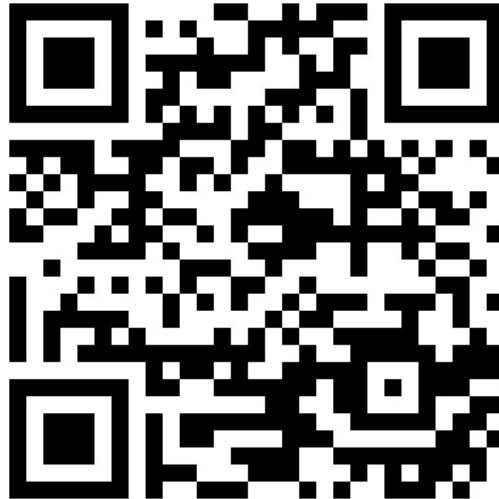
